

## The Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**RESPONSORIAL PSALM:** *“In the sight of the angels I will sing your praises, Lord.”*

*After Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon Peter, "Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a catch!" The Holy Father John Paul II proposed Jesus' imperative "Put out into the deep water" as the motto of the Church. He did this because so often we in the Church today can feel that we're in Peter's shoes. In many areas of life, but particularly in our discipleship, we can work so hard and seem to have so little to show for it. We're called, like Peter, Andrew, James and John to leave behind whatever might keep us from the Lord and follow him, being sent out into the deep water of the world to fish for souls. We're called, like St. Paul, to "work harder than any" of the rest, because of the Lord's great mercy, love and trust in calling us and sending us.*

### WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

The 27<sup>th</sup> World Day of the Sick of the Catholic Church is being celebrated on Monday in the eastern Indian city of Kolkata (formerly Calcutta), the capital of West Bengal state. The annual day was instituted by St. John Paul II on 13 May 1992, designating its celebration to the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, February 11 each year. The purpose is to draw attention to the sick and their caregivers and the redemptive nature of human suffering. The first World Day of the Sick was marked in 1993 at the shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes in southern France, one of the world's most famous Marian shrines. Since then, the day has been observed each year all over the world with a special celebration in a particular place. The Holy Father issues a message each year on a particular theme. Pope Francis on Dec. 11 appointed Bangladeshi Cardinal Patrick D'Rozario as his envoy to the 2019 World Day of the Sick in Kolkata, which has as its theme, **“You received without payment; give without payment” (Mt 10:8)**. In a personal letter to the Cardinal, he says, the Holy Father appreciated his “spirit of communion” with the people, especially the poor. The Cardinal notes that the Pope in his message for the World Day of the Sick also stresses on communion, which entails giving generously to others because we have received freely from the Lord. We should give ourselves to people especially those most in need. Card. D'Rozario says the **Feb. 9-11 World Day of the Sick** will include reflections, prayers and communicating with others and showing mercy and compassion to the poor and the neediest.

### CATHECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

**57. What is the ultimate reason for God revealing His “plan of loving goodness”?** (CCC 51)The ultimate reason for God revealing His “plan of loving goodness” is to make men sharers in the divine nature.

**58. Why, according to St Irenaeus, does God communicate Himself to man gradually?** (CCC 53)According to St Irenaeus († 200) God communicates Himself to man gradually, in order to accustom man to perceive God and to accustom God to dwell in man. St Irenaeus of Lyons (France) is one of the early Church Fathers.

**59. Which are the four main stages of Revelation in the Old Testament?** (CCC 54-64)The four main stages of Revelation in the Old Testament are:

1. God’s manifesting Himself to Adam and Eve
2. the covenant with Noah
3. the vocation of Abraham
4. the forming of the People of God through Moses and the prophets.

**60. What was the first stage of God’s Revelation to man?** (CCC 54)The first stage of God’s Revelation to man was when He manifested Himself to our first parents, Adam and Eve.

**61. Was God’s first manifestation to man broken off by Adam and Eve’s sin?** (CCC 55)No, God’s first manifestation to man was not broken off by Adam and Eve’s sin. After the Fall God kept speaking to them.

**62. What was the second stage of God’s Revelation to man?** (CCC 56)The second stage of God’s Revelation to man was His manifestation to Noah and His covenant with him.

**63. What is the covenant with Noah?** (CCC 56)The covenant with Noah is God’s pact with Noah, his descendants and all the animals promising them that the earth shall never again be destroyed by a flood (Gen 9:9).

The rainbow is a sign of the covenant of God with Noah. until the universal proclamation of the Gospel at the end of times.
