

Twenty Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: “The Lord is merciful and gracious; slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast Love .”

In today's Gospel reading Peter asks Jesus how many times one ought to extend forgiveness to another. Peter proposes a reasonable number of times, perhaps seven. Jesus replies by extending Peter's proposal by an enormous amount; not just seven times should one forgive, but 77 times. The parable of the unforgiving servant is Jesus' elaboration of his initial reply to Peter. Through the parable we come to understand the depths of God's mercy toward us and the results of our acceptance of God's forgiveness. There is a temptation to quantify forgiveness as Peter tried to do, but Jesus' point is that forgiveness is not about quantity—the number of times we extend forgiveness to another. In the parable the king's forgiveness is like God's forgiveness, and it transforms us, helping us to be as forgiving as God. The lesson is clear: If we hoard God's mercy while showing no mercy to others, we risk forfeiting the effects of God's mercy in our lives.

INDULGENCE - In the teaching of the Catholic Church, an indulgence is "a way to reduce the amount of punishment one has to undergo for sins". The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes an indulgence as "a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and all of the saints".

To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father. The three conditions may be fulfilled several days before or after the performance of the visit; it is, however, fitting that communion be received and the prayer for the intention of the Holy Father be said on the same day as the visit. The condition of praying for the intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary.

COVID19 - REMINDER

According to the by-law passed by the Region of Peel the use of masks or face coverings inside all public places is mandatory. This includes churches and our own parish. All those coming to church should bring a mask or face covering and wear it upon entering the church. Exceptions to the by-law include people who cannot wear a mask for medical reasons (trouble breathing or unable to remove a mask without assistance) and children under two years old.

- Until further notice to provide the church with the required distance of 2 meters between liturgy participants, seats on the benches that indicate where to sit are marked with yellow tape. While entering the bench we take the place starting from the center seat and then we fill up rest of

them in such order - it will allow us to get as many people as possible in the church.

Until further notice, the Holy Communion can be received on hand only. Those who do not receive Holy Communion walk in procession, with their arms crossed on their chests and receive blessing.

- To increase the number of people who may be in the church, the bench section on the left in the main passage will be reserved for families, as they do not maintain 2 meter social distancing within the same household.

- We only use bathrooms when absolutely necessary
- We encourage you to use a personal disinfectant before entering the church.

- The offerings will be collected after the end of Mass. At the exit of the church there will be tables with the baskets for the offerings..

- After the Mass, please do not gather for social purposes in the parking lot.

- The Holy Mass at 11:00 we would like to continue to dedicate to families with children as much as possible, therefore we ask that people without small children choose different Holy Masses to participate.

- Please be advised that until further notice confessions will be held from Monday to Friday at 8:00am and 6:00pm.

- The Mass' are also transmitted live on parish TV
