

<u>RESPONSORIAL PSALM:</u> "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want"



Christ has not changed: He is the same yesterday, today and forever. He has the same compassion for us that He had for those Galileans; we too are often like sheep without a shepherd wandering half-lost through life. He is ever calling us to come to Himself so that He will lead us to safe pastures. If only we would listen to His merciful call! O God, who by the Precious Blood of Your only Begotten Son have redeemed the whole world, preserve in us the work of Your mercy, so that, ever honoring the mystery of our salvation, we may merit to obtain its fruits.
