

THE TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR B)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: "The precepts of the Lord give joy to the heart."

In today's Gospel, the disciple John questions Jesus about an unknown exorcist who was driving out demons in Jesus' name. John's question might have been motivated by jealousy. Previously in Mark's Gospel, Jesus healed a boy whom the disciples had been unable to heal. John's question is further evidence that the disciples have not yet grasped Jesus' words to them. They continue to compare themselves to others who seem to have greater healing powers, and they do not want to share the power of Jesus' name with others. Later in this Gospel, Jesus teaches us not to create obstacles for those who are just beginning to have faith but to encourage even the smallest signs of faith. The Greek word used here for sin also connotes "stumbling" or "causing scandal." In vivid terms, Jesus teaches his disciples the consequences to those who would put obstacles before people who are on the road to faith.
