### JUNE- MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART

June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Through St. Margaret Mary  
Alacoque, the Lord revealed 12 promises to those  
who honor His Heart:

- 1) I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2) I will establish peace in their homes.
- 3) I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- 4) I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- 5) I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- 6) Sinners will find in my heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7) Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- 8) Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- 9) I will bless every place in which an image of my heart is exposed and honored.
- 10) I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11) Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart.
- 12) I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.
