THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF CHRIST



Saint Gaspar del Bufalo was honoured by Pope John XXIII as "the world's greatest apostle of the devotion to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus." In the early 20th century, he fervently spread this devotion across the months, inspiring churches throughout Rome and beyond. After May's dedication to Mary and June's to the Most Sacred

Heart of Jesus, the Church wisely designated July for the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. July, the heart of the solar year, is characterized by the sun's intense heat, reflecting the miraculous grace found in the Divine Blood, which brings life to souls through Christ's love. This timing serves as a poignant reminder of the fullness of Redemption. Additionally, July often brings a decline in Christian fervour, as worldly concerns can overshadow faith. During this time, the Blood of Christ becomes our essential source of strength, renewing our commitment and helping us overcome life's challenges. Embracing this devotion empowers us to remain steadfast in our faith amidst distractions.

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Christ.

Following May, which is dedicated to Mary, and June, which honours the Sacred Heart of Jesus, July is offered to the Precious Blood of Christ.
