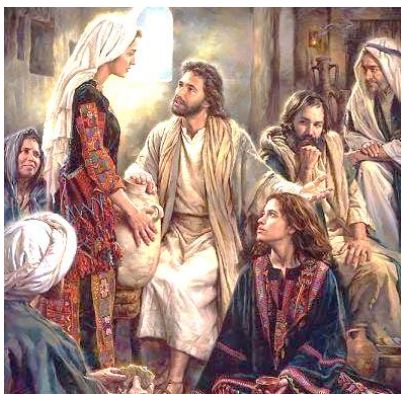




## SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, year „c”
