Let us reflect on the fact that when the Lord Jesus entered the temple, He did not expel those who were poorly dressed, unwashed, children who disrupted prayer, those who genuflected improperly, or individuals who sang off-key. His actions were directed solely at the merchants. Now, think about how much we engage in a transactional mindset in our relationship with God—how often we find ourselves bargaining within our hearts, which are truly meant to be His temple. We frequently seek to receive "something in return." We give, yet we expect to be repaid. When we consecrate our churches, we dedicate them without seeking anything in exchange. But what about my heart? Is it a consecrated temple as well? Or have I merely constructed a temple for God that exists primarily to gain something in return?

The most important Polish national holiday commemorates the country's independence regained in 1918, after 123 years of partitions. November 11 was first established as a public holiday in 1937. During the Nazi German occupation from 1939 to 1944, and under the communist regime from 1945 to 1989, it was forbidden to celebrate this day. It was only in 1989, through an act of Parliament, that the holiday was officially reinstated. In Canada, we celebrate this day along with Remembrance Day!
