With gratitude, we give thanks for the mercy God has shown us. Yet without faith, without prayer, and without the grace of God at work within us, we risk losing ourselves among empty words and lifeless formulas.

JUNE- THE MONTH of THE SACRED HEART of JESUS

The month of June is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. What can we do for Him, and how can we respond to His great love for us? The Catechism teaches us the Corporal Works of Mercy:

The 7-corporal works of mercy

1. Feed the hungry.
2. Give drink to the thirsty.
3. Clothe the naked.
4. Welcome the stranger.
5. Visit and comfort the imprisoned.
6. Care for the sick.
7. Bury the dead.
