The usual conditions for obtaining a plenary indulgence are:

- Devout participation in the procession.
- Being in the state of grace (having received sacramental Confession).
- Reception of Holy Communion.
- Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father (e.g. *Our Father* and *Hail Mary*).
- Freedom from attachment to any sin, even venial sin.
