JUNE- THE MONTH of THE SACRED HEART of JESUS

8. Fervent souls will quickly attain great perfection.
9. I will bless every home in which an image of My Heart is displayed and honoured.
10. I will give priests the grace to touch even the hardest hearts.
11. The names of those who spread this devotion will be written in My Heart and will never be erased.
12. In the excess of the mercy of My Heart, I promise that My all-powerful love will grant the grace of final repentance to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months. They shall not die in My displeasure or without the sacraments, and My Heart will be their secure refuge at the hour of death.
