RESPONSORIAL PSALM: *"Lord, you have the words of eternal life"*



John, the only one among the evangelists, notes that, in addition to the vendors, sheep and oxen were also driven out. The gesture of Jesus has decreed the end of religion related to the offerings of animals. He declared God's refusal of bloody sacrifices whose inconsistency had been denounced by the prophets: "What do I care—says the Lord—for your endless sacrifices? I am fed up with your burnt offerings, and the fat of your bulls. The blood of fatlings and lambs and the-goats I abhor" (Is 1:11). In the greatest proof of love that Jesus was going to give, the only sacrifice pleasing to the Father would be shown, the one, John would have said to the Christians of his community: "This is how we have known what love is; He gave His life for us, for our brothers and sisters" (1 Jn 3:16).
