


THE TWENTY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



<u>RESPONSORIAL PSALM:</u> "I will walk before the Lord, in the land of the living."

Although the message was only vaguely and dubiously grasped, Christ had forewarned his Apostles (he repeated this twice later: Mk. 9: 9-10; 31-32 and 10: 32-34), so as to prepare them for the scandal of the cross. While it did not really prepare them because they were still too worldly-minded, it did help to strengthen their faith once the facts convinced them of the resurrection. They then realized that their beloved Master was more than Messiah, that He was in fact the Son of God, who with knowledge aforethought freely accepted His humiliations and shameful death for their sakes and ours. They gladly gave their lives to bringing this news of God's great love for men to all nations.

From being a scandal the cross became the emblem and the proud standard of God's love for mankind. Life on earth is very short, eternal life is endless. No rational man, and certainly no true Christian, would risk losing the eternal life for the sake of a few paltry gains or a few extra years here below.
